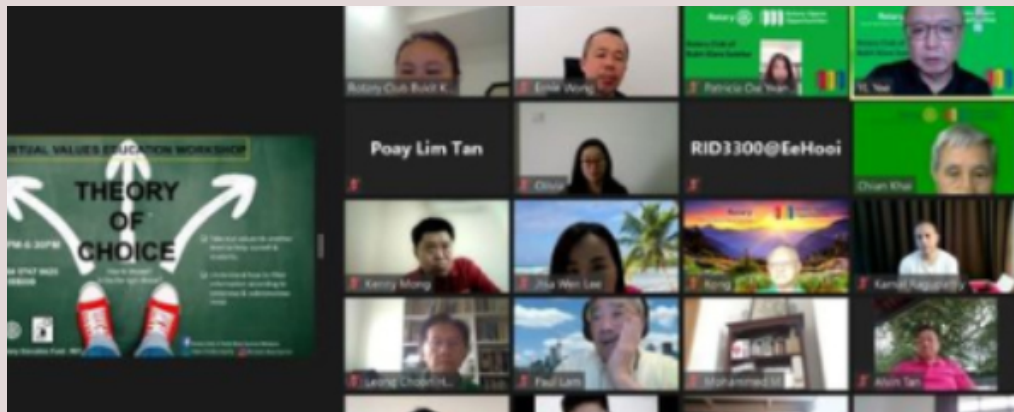
Students for Sustainability: Bringing Knowledge to the Ground
